Our initiatives include

- Principal, Deputy Principal and HOD-C (Head of Department - Curriculum); to facilitate professional development and coaching for all teachers in how to make learning visible in the classroom using:
 - Learning intentions
 - Guide to Making Judgement Documents (Success Criteria)
- Teachers to provide timely and explicit feedback to students based on success criteria
- Feedback given to teachers to inform planning, teaching experiences and pedagogy
- Provision of professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum: English and provide targeted supported instruction to secure highly effective first teaching of concepts and skills in every classroom
- Building teacher capacity to ensure all data gathered is disaggregated and directly informs teaching and learning
- Utilising a quality case management process to identify student's improvement needs to allow positive growth in achievement
- Investment of funding in teacher capability development and planning through a collaborative focus on moderation
