Our initiatives include

- Principal, Deputy Principal and HOC to facilitate professional development and coaching for all teachers in how to make learning visible in the classroom using:
 - Learning intentions
 - Guide to Making Judgement Documents (Success Criteria)
- Teachers to provide timely and explicit feedback to students based on success criteria
- Feedback given to teachers to inform planning and teaching experiences and pedagogy
- Provide professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum: English and provide targeted supported instruction to secure highly effective first teaching of concepts and skills in every classroom.
- Build teacher capability to use technology to differentiate and improve learning.



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Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ a Head of Curriculum (Literacy and Numeracy) 8 days per fortnight to model best practice pedagogy and provide quality feedback on teacher pedagogy - \$95000
- Employ full time Science technology teacher to allow teachers more time to concentrate on the core areas of English and Mathematics - \$107000
